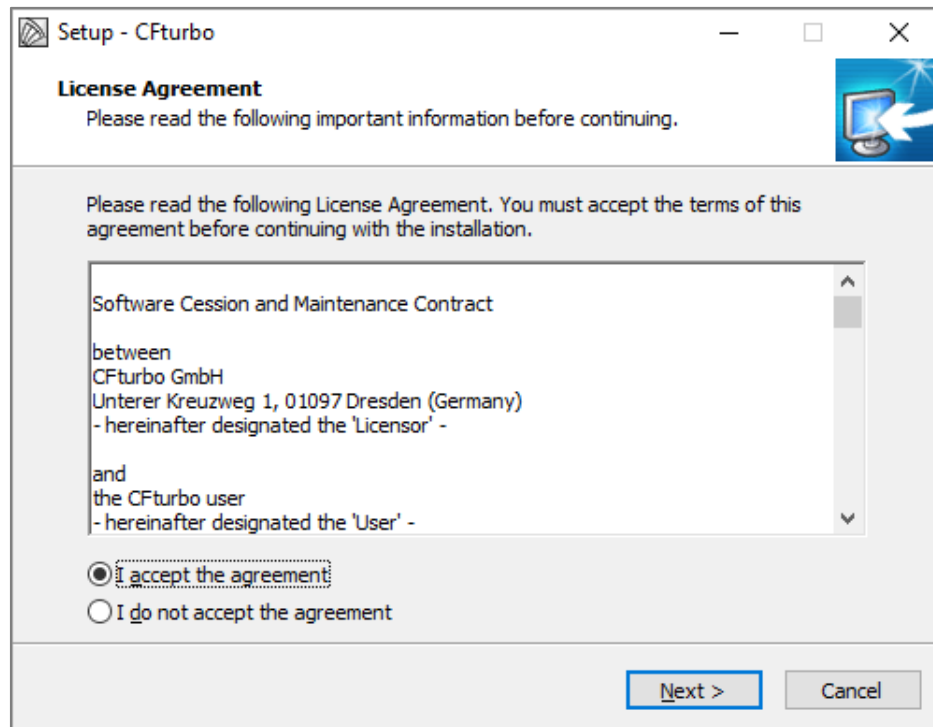
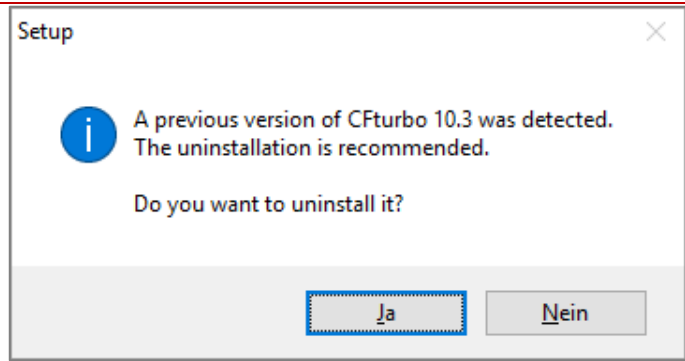

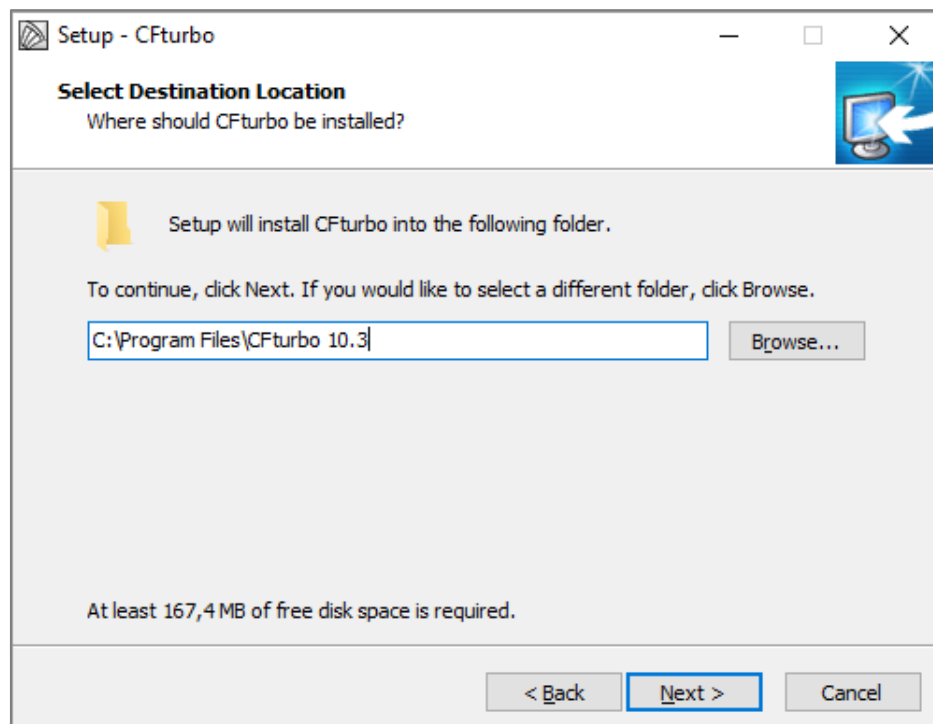
2 Installation

Start the installation program
cfturbo10.3.*_setup_win64.exe.

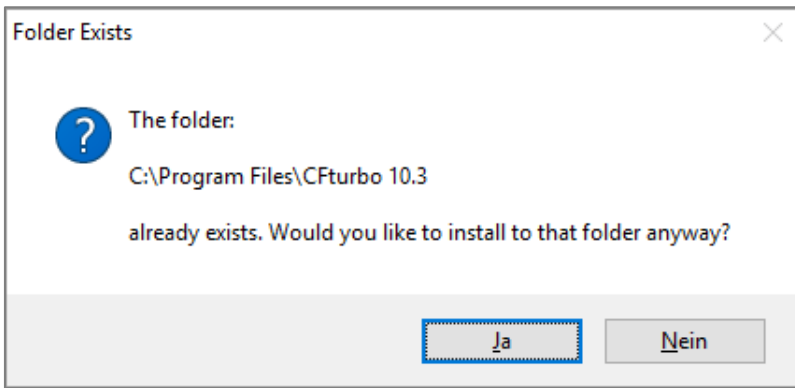
Uninstall existing version optionally.



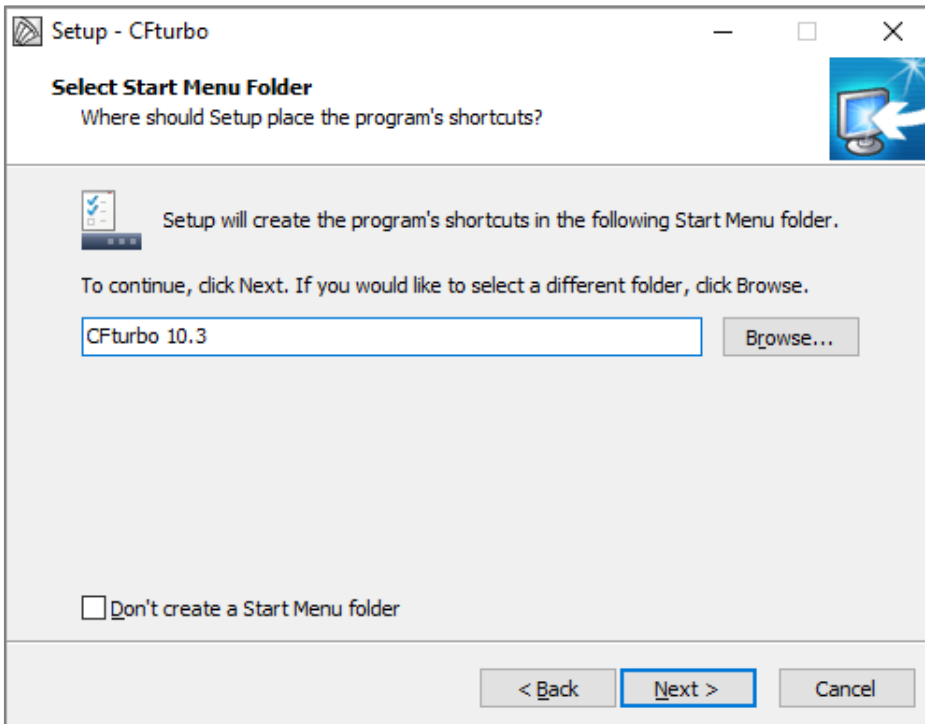
Accept the license agreement.



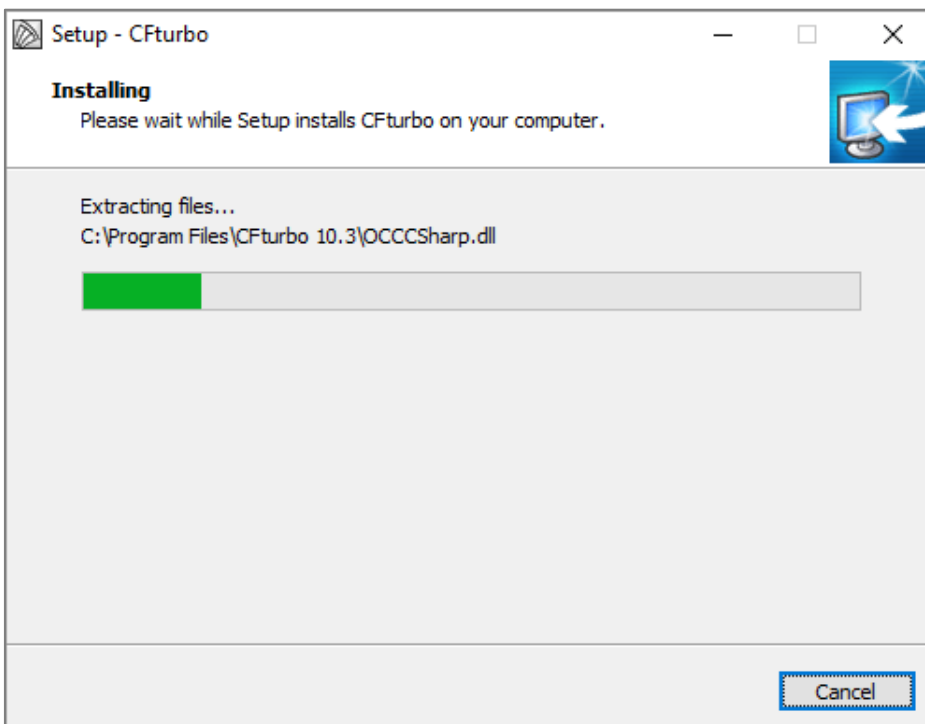
Accept or select the destination directory.



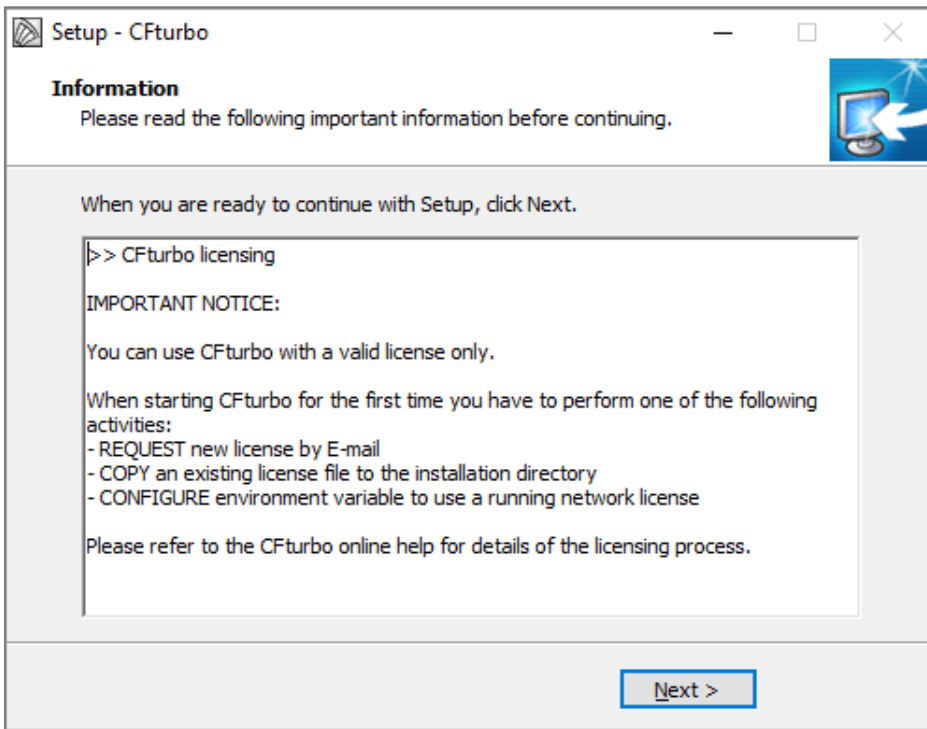
If the directory already exists, you can accept this and overwrite the existing installation.



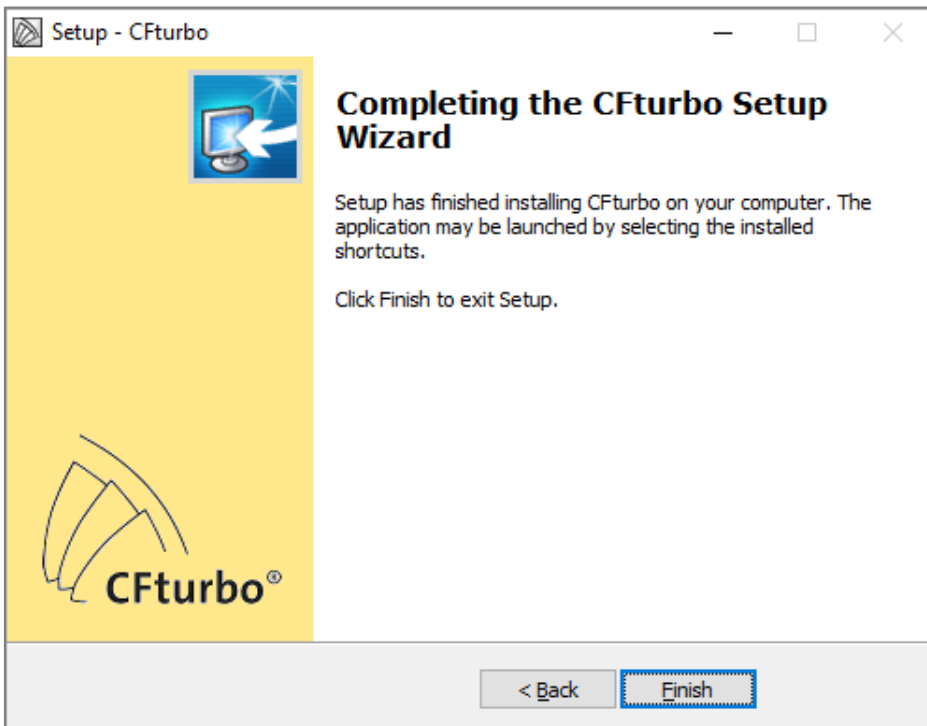
Accept or modify the start menu name.

After successful installation of the software CFturbo you need to perform the licensing.

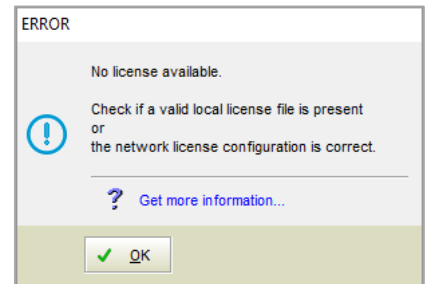

Local (nodelocked) license

For local client licensing the following steps are required:

① Start CFturbo®

After starting CFturbo® you see a message indicating that there is no valid license available.




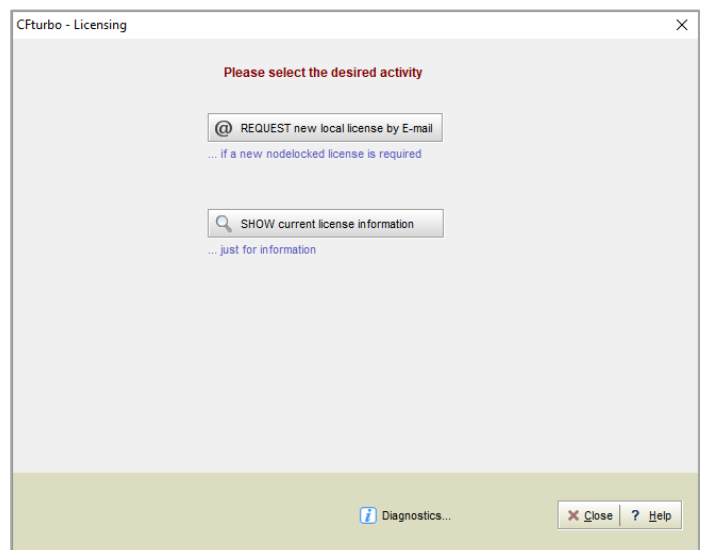
After clicking <OK> the "Licensing" starts automatically (or use menu PREFERENCES / Licensing).

② Use CFturbo® Licensing

Initially the Licensing is used to

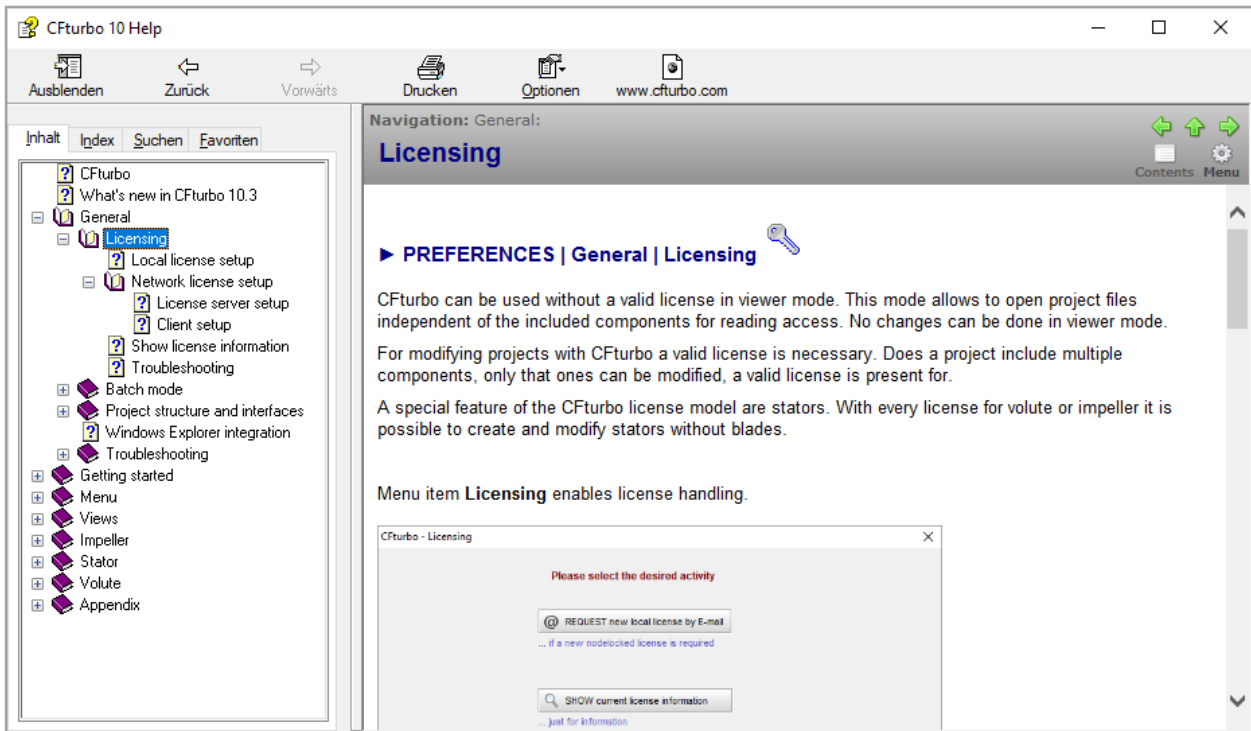
- a) **REQUEST** new local license by E-mail
If no valid CFturbo® license exists on your computer you have to request a new license by E-mail from within CFturbo®.
- b) **SHOW** current license information
The current licensing status for all CFturbo modules is displayed.
